Hostel

Wombat City Hostel is a modern hostel. It is located in Central London, close to the river Thames and within short walking distance to Tower Bridge. The reception is open 24 hours/day, and the hostel offers free wi-fi. It has big and good outdoor and indoor common areas, and it is possible to cook for yourselves in a shared kitchen. A continental breakfast buffet is served.

You will be staying in rooms of 4-8 beds with private bath and toilet. In the rooms you will find lockers. You need to bring your own towel but linen is provided.

Sunday 14 October 2018

Departure in Billund: Billund Airport

We meet at 9.00 in the departure section of Billund Airport

We will be flying Brithish Airways departing at 11.15 (BA 805) Arrival in Heathrow at 12.10

We go together in the underground to Wombat City Hostel from the airport

Friday 19 October 2018

Departure Heathrow: We go together from Wombat City Hostel at 13.00 towards the underground.

We will be flying British Airways departing at 16.05 Arrival in Billund at 18.45

Transportation to and from Billund Airport is organised and paid by you.

Transportation in London

Contactless visa cards can be used at all entrances/exits, and the price is the same as for the other cards.

It is possible to order oyster cards, visitor oyster cards and travelcards prior to leaving. You can also buy tickets on site.

The hostel provides linen for the beds.

Luggage

You are allowed to bring:

- 1 suitcase (checked-in luggage) max. 23 kg (height(90)/width(75)/depth(43))
- 1 carry-on luggage max. 23 kg (H56xW45xD25)

You are allowed to bring *one* 1-litre reclosable bag for liquids in your carry-on luggage. In this bag, you can bring as many containers (100ml) as fits in it. Otherwise, you can bring liquids in your checked-in luggage.
